- -Students will have to study 60 hours of French (no level required) before going to France (CUEB will organize for you)
- -Paris Novancia requires TEF 70 (French language test)
- -need to attend 1 module in Beijing about "Europe and European Economy"
- <u>-For Novancia</u>: to get the degree students will need to take an official TOEIC test in Paris. It will be organized for FREE in France around December. Students must pay attention. If fail the date, then will have to pay for the test

Internship in Novancia

- Can be done in China or France
- If in China need to send to France a detailled abstract in english, with methodology and conclusion of your internship report
