- -Need to take 36 hrs of French language training in China before departure (no requirement as to the level to achieve

#### • In China:

- two (2) academic semesters to meet the degree requirements of MIB program at CUEB including a master's thesis.
- six (6) months professional experience (internship) in China or abroad, acknowledged as an equivalence from CUEB

#### In France :

- two (2) academic semesters from September to April/ with 60 ECTS including a master's thesis.
- three (3) months professional experience (internship) <u>in France</u> or abroad, acknowledged as an equivalence from ESC Clermont or Brest

# <u>Internship</u>

- For French internship
  - Compulsory in Clermont and Brest: 3 months
  - Can be done in France, in China or any other country
  - Defence can be done in France or in China
  - If not done in France, then need to write a summary in English with enough details and information
- For CUEB China internship
  - Need to be 6 (six) months
  - Need to prepare a specific document in Chinese check requirements with CUEB

# Process details

- no tuition fees ONLY 2 seats available for each program (if more applicant, then tuition fees to pay in France 25% discount)
- 210 euros health insurance in France for students
- living expenses: we estimate 600 euros per month is enough to cover accommodation and daily expenses.

- Bachelor degree copy
- Bachelor transcript
- Master, certificate from CUEB with the list of courses attended in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester.
- Motivation letter
- Resume
- Recommendation letter from English language teacher
- Copy of passport/ID card
