About the program and B.School

- Member French Ivy league - Accreditations: fully accredited by the French Ministry of Education, Novancia and Dijon are AACSB
- Programs taught in English (you will learn French as a foreign language)
- Part of Chamber of commerce (highly professional).
- Structure of the Program: 1 semester in France in your 3rd year of bachelor
- Structure of the Program in France : one (1) academic semester from September to December
- In France, contact hours are “limited”. **Personal work is more important**

Advantages & Requirements

- **Advantages of French Business schools for Foreign (Chinese) students:**
 - Programs are designed to provide value for future company managers, very practical and based on projects
 - Long experience welcoming international students
 - Medium sized school, with small sized class (each student is followed individually), individual support for all administrative issues
- **Requirements:**
 - be a Bachelor student enrolled at CUEB 3rd year
 - Minimum score at TOEIC 750 or TOEFL 550 or equivalent English test.
 - Students will have to study 60 hours of French (no level required) before going to France (CUEB will organize for you)

 - need to attend module in Beijing about “Europe and European Economy”

 - no need to have “management” experience

Process details

- **Details of fees:**
- NO tuition fees
- 210 euros health insurance in France for students per year (1 semester also need to pay)
- Living expenses: we estimate 750 euros per month is enough to cover accommodation and daily expenses in Paris and Dijon

- **Application form documents needed:**
 - English test.
 - Certificate of registration at CUEB
 - Certificate from CUEB with the list of courses attended and grades in the 1st and 2nd year
 - Motivation letter
 - Resume
 - Copy of passport/ID card

 - Only 2 students admitted for each program

- interview in Beijing March 3rd lunch-time
- Admission Results: around March 15
- Need to start application to Campus-France May 1
- Training for visa interview – date to be confirmed
- Deadline to get all documents before June 1st
- Arrival date to Dijon around sept 12, Paris Aug 27
- Class starts sept 19 In Dijon and Aug 31 In Paris
